Announcing a Change in Membership Structure

As BeLoved Care continues to grow and move forward, the Board has decided to transition from our current closed board governance model to an open board structure that includes open membership.

This transition represents an important step toward strengthening transparency, accountability, and collaboration with the churches and supporters who share in this work. By establishing an open membership, BeLoved Care will be better positioned to foster meaningful dialogue, encourage broader engagement, and remain responsive to the community it serves.

Membership will be available to individuals who belong to churches that hold to the Three Forms of Unity or the Westminster Standards and who agree to BeLoved Care's Mission, Vision and Values. Annual membership will be \$50 and will include the ability to vote at our Annual General Meeting each spring.

Membership will be opt-in, and a formal membership campaign will be launched this fall with clear instructions on how to join. If you are already supporting BeLoved Care through one-time or monthly donations, you will be given the opportunity to include membership as part of your giving, if you wish.
